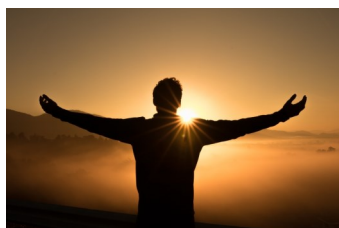

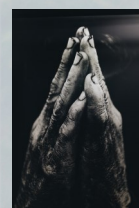
Please pray for those in hospital and those recovering at home.
