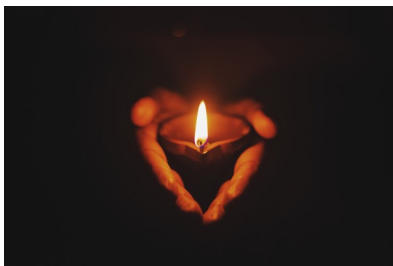

Thank Offering Sunday

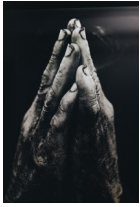
