The newcomers' reception date has changed to Sunday 20th March due to Covid.

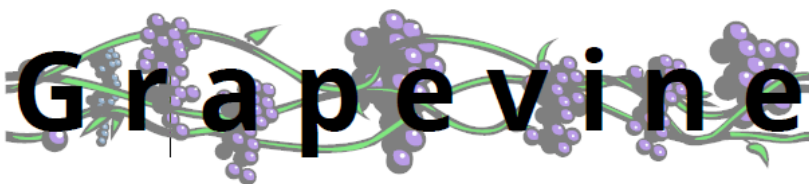
The new directory is available!

Muriel Warner would like to thank everyone for the cards received, she was absolutely overwhelmed.

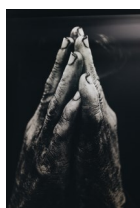
Please continue to pray for all those who have been bereaved in recent weeks and months.
