# **Marriage Matters**



A day for all who are married or living in committed relationships. We will be using the *Marriage Session* resources by Care for the Family. This material is specifically created to help couples develop and strengthen their relationships. The aims of the day are to:

- Equip couples at whatever stage of their relationship to communicate well and connect at a deeper level.
- Build couples confidence and knowledge in how to strengthen their marriage
- Encourage couples to collaborate through challenges and conflict.

#### **Every couple is welcome**

- This is a great opportunity to enjoy a couple of hours together without too many distractions and know your children will be cared for (if you cannot find any one else to.)
- This time together may well prove to be significant in your relationship.
- Every couple is welcome, in fact encouraged to come, no matter how things are going in your relationship. Every marriage has its ups and downs, so if things are tough right now, choosing to attend would be a great decision. If things are going well, attending would help to strengthen and enrich your relationship further.
- This is not a test of your marriage. Rather than something that makes you feel pressurised the day is designed to be encouraging, inspiring and equipping.

#### Some important information.

- There is no group work involved in the day, although there will be time during the day for couples to discuss the content with each other and any conversation will be private, no one will be asked to speak publicly about their relationships. Try to get there if you can.
- There is NO cost for the day.


